Teachers use this assessment data to determine current proficiency levels on the curricular outcomes/strand your child has been assessed on thus far in the school year. These proficiency levels are then applied to your child's Edsby report card.

On January 31st, report cards will be published to your Edsby portal. **You will require an Edsby account to view your child's report card.** If you have not already done so, please find the Edsby invitation in your email or contact your school. Shortly after 3:30pm, you will be able to click on the "View Report Cards" button on your Edsby portal **under** your child's list of classes.

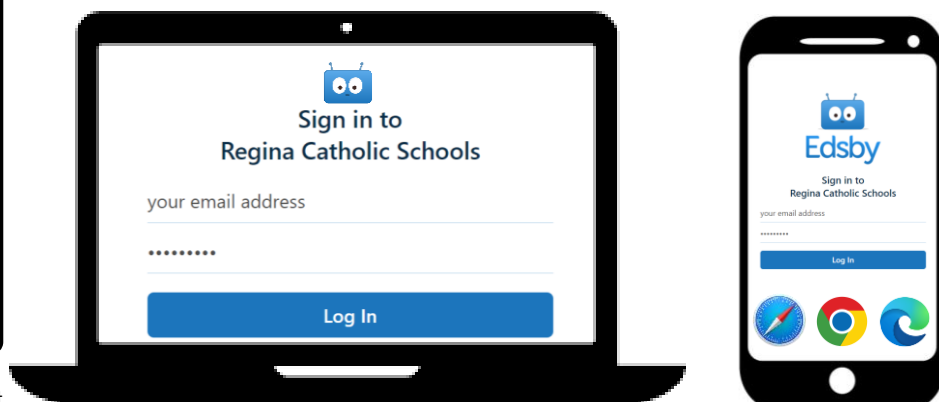
