

Students exhibiting symptoms:

- Please note to use the self-assessment Provincial tool or the Regina Catholic symptom checker daily before sending your child to school, if any symptoms exist- we are requesting that you keep your child at-home for 48 hours.

- If your child exhibits any symptoms and they are sent home, they will be sent home and we are asking for them to be away for a full 48 hours. So for example, if they are sent home at noon on Monday, we are asking they return on Thursday.

- Should Public Health direct you otherwise, you can contact myself or our Office Manager directly at the school and ensure you have the confirmation from either 811 or the eHealth verification. For the call to 811, confirmation could be the name of the nurse, plus the date and time of the call so we can verify with them. A doctor's note, we are open to receiving a note from them, or some form of documentation from them (screenshot, email, etc).

COVID-19 has presented a number of obstacles, inconveniences, and challenges for us all. We are attempting to act with guidance from our Chief and Regional Medical Officers during this time to ensure we are being as diligent as possible to protect the health of all students and staff during this pandemic.
